WEEK THREE

THE JOY OF HEARING GOD'S VOICE AND LIVING IN GOD'S WORD

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DAY 1

Read the following scriptures in two different translations: Genesis 2:16, 24; 3:1–12; Genesis 4:6–16; 7:1; Genesis 6:1–9; Genesis 15:1–2.

Are there any people in the Old Testament who heard God's Voice and lived according to His "Word"?

From the passages above, who were they and how do you know there was communication with God?

How did they respond to God's voice?

DAY 2

Read Genesis chapters 15 – 24.

Take notes on how God communicated with Abraham.

What were the benefits of Abraham giving "ear" to God's voice?

From the last two days what was the criteria for man to hear and live with God? List what you find in your notes.

DAY 3

Can you find other examples in the Old Testament where men hear God? Write the examples and passages.

DAY 4

Read Genesis 3: 23,24; Genesis 4:16.

Also read Psalm 66:18; Isaiah 1:15; 59:2; Zechariah 7:11–13; Micah 3:2–4; Jeremiah 11:11–14; James 4:3; John 9:31; Romans 3:23.

God is adamant and very clear when He does not “hear.” What is the consequence for SIN?

DAY 5

Read Leviticus 26:11–12; Deuteronomy 5:33; 10:12; 11:19,22; 23:14. God wants to be very near us. Also read Exodus 29:45–46; Philippians 4:4–7.

How close does He long to be?

So where does He long to live? (2 Timothy 1:14)

DAY 6

Read 1 John 2:27; 1 John 3:24; 1 John 4:12–13; 5:13–14; Galatians 5:16,25; Romans 14:7.

How do we learn to hear Him?

Read James: 1:6–7, Psalm 51:10; Matthew 7:7; 1 John 5:14.

What are practical truths for hearing God?

DAY 7

Meditate on all the previous passages. How do they speak to you?

Would you say you are “walking” with God?

Write in your journal what God is saying to you. He is talking to you! Is there action you need to take? Are you listening?

Worship Him! Take the Sabbath and remember He is Enough!
