



## What I Love about the Discipleship Summit

The Discipleship Summit is one of my favorite conferences. The setting is in the middle of beautiful Amish farm country. The rooms are pleasant and welcoming. The atmosphere is serene, and the presence of Jesus is felt in every area of the Inn. Women come with tender hearts (and some weary hearts), expecting to see Jesus, and He Comes to meet us!

During one of our prayer times, He came and met me; although at first I did not recognize His touch. I felt a little "hook" catch hold of my heart, an ache that I could not explain and that grew greater. In the evening service, the pain in my heart did not lessen or go away, so I asked my friend, "Jesus, what is this?"
