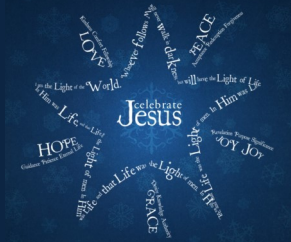




## CELEBRATE JESUS THROUGH 31 DAYS OF PRAYER

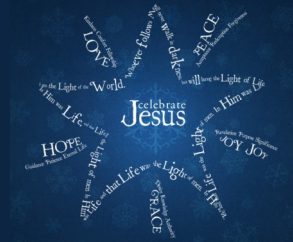
1. Ask Jesus how to orchestrate plans this month; ask Him to anoint everything from events to gift giving (Col. 3:1,2; 16,17).
